Always observe standard precautions



Practice hand hygiene (the 5 Moments of WHO) before and after contact with any patient.



Thoroughly clean and disinfect shared patient equipment.



Use personal protective equipment (PPE) when there is a risk of exposure to bodily fluids.



Maintain respiratory hygiene and follow proper sneezing and coughing etiquette.



Dispose of sharp and cutting instruments safely, following necessary precautions.



Follow aseptic techniques.



Handle and dispose of waste carefully, adhering to safety protocols.
